Dear Referee Applicant,

The Board of Directors of the Redondo Beach Youth Basketball organization are excited about the upcoming season and are pleased that you have an interest in participating as a referee or game official for the league.

Last year RBYB had over 700 children from throughout the south bay area play on 75 boys and girls teams. Approximately 20 students and adults applied as Jr. and Sr. referees and worked league games as Floor, Scorebook, and Clock officials. All student game officials worked alongside Certified CIF Referees during the season.

This year the Referee Coordinator will be Cameron Bowles

The Referee Coordinator responsibilities include:

- Preseason Planning - Contacting former and new student referees, application mailings, and follow up correspondence.
- Referee Development - referee clinic training and referee evaluation
- Game Referee Administration - game assignment of all RBYB Jr. referees and scorekeeping officials, coordinating invoicing and payment for RBYB officials by RBYB Treasurer

To complete the process, please complete a Referee Application and return it to the address listed above on or before November 1st. All Referee applications will be reviewed the Referee Coordinator and submitted to the RBYB Board for approval. Referee application forms can be downloaded from the RBYB.org website documents page

All returning/new referees and game officials will be required to complete a Referee Code of Conduct agreement. All returning/new referees and game officials are required to participate and attend the following training sessions. Failure to do so may make you ineligible for referee consideration.

Please check the RBYB Calendar page for dates and times of Referee Meetings and Training dates and locations.

For the benefit of those referees new to the league and those returning Jr. and Sr. Referees, you are reminded that the primary focus of RBYB is the teaching of basketball fundamentals, teamwork, sportsmanship, and the promotion of character development. Your primary responsibility is to insure on-time game starts by being at the gym 30 minutes before game time and control of game play to prevent player injury and insure players, parents and coaches have fun and learn the game.
